- Pass the BlueCat Fundamentals Certified Professional (BFCP) exam



The BlueCat Advanced Certified Professional (BACP) designation certifies that users have the requisite skills to manage features and topics covered in the BlueCat Security and Advanced Configuration course. It is strongly recommended that you complete the BlueCat Fundamentals course prior to taking the BlueCat Security and Advanced Configuration course. Upon completion of the BlueCat Security and Advanced Configuration course, you may take the BlueCat Advanced Certified Professional (BACP) exam to become BACP certified.

### BACP Certification Steps:

- Course 1 – BlueCat Fundamentals

Required course to complete:

- Course 2 – BlueCat Security and Advanced Configuration
- Pass the BlueCat Advanced Certified Professional (BACP) exam



The BlueCat Support Certified Professional (BCSP) designation certifies that users have the requisite skills to provide Tier One support for the BlueCat Address Manager and BlueCat DNS and DHCP servers. It is strongly recommended that you complete the BlueCat Fundamentals course prior to taking the BlueCat Support Certified Professional exam. Upon completion of the BlueCat Support Provider eLearning course, you may take the BlueCat Support Provider (BCSP) exam to become BCSP certified.

Required course to complete:

- BlueCat Support Certified Professional – Level 1 eLearning
- Pass the BlueCat Advanced Certified Professional (BACP) exam
